### **Individual License to Access Electronic Content via User Name and Password**

Subscribers may gain access to the electronic version of The Journal of Clinical Ethics (JCE) via User Name and Password. To activate access, please read the following.

#### **Prepayment is required**

Subscribers must have a prepaid subscription to the electronic version of The Journal of Clinical Ethics (JCE), or have a prepaid print + electronic subscription, to access the electronic version of JCE. To purchase a subscription to JCE, Subscribers may contact Mary Gesford using the contact information listed above. A Subscriber with a paid subscription to the electronic version of JCE should print out, complete, and return a copy of this License to register his or her User Name and Password. JCE will alert the Subscriber by e-mail when the Subscriber's electronic access is activated.

**1. The License.** By signing this license (License), the Subscriber identified below (Subscriber) agrees to the terms and conditions set forth in this License. In turn, The Journal of Clinical Ethics (JCE) grants the Subscriber the right to access the electronic version of The Journal of Clinical Ethics subject to these same terms and conditions. JCE reserves the right to change the terms of this agreement with prior notice of thirty (30) days, which may be by e-mail, fax, or other communication.

JCE will notify the Subscriber by e-mail when the Subscriber's access to the electronic version of JCE is active. The Subscriber will have access to electronic content within five business days of receipt of payment and receipt of the Subscriber's User Name and Password by JCE.

The Subscriber should send any changes in contact information to [JCE@ClinicalEthics.com](mailto:JCE@ClinicalEthics.com). The electronic version of JCE corresponds in content to the print version. JCE is a quarterly journal and subscription is by volume year (spring, summer, fall, and winter). The Subscriber is permitted online access to the electronic version of JCE to which the Subscriber maintains a valid subscription; this is subject to confirmation by JCE and is subject to amendment. Access rights to the electronic version of JCE are limited to the volume years that are available in electronic version that have been purchased by the Subscriber.

**2. Terms and conditions.** A subscription to the electronic version of JCE extends only to the Subscriber individually and this subscription may not be transferred to, or extended to, any other individual or institution. Those Subscribers who access electronic content via ID number/password agree to maintain their ID number/password as private and confidential information; unauthorized use of a Subscriber's ID number/password, with or without his or her knowledge, is a breach of this Agreement and a violation of JCE's copyrights, and may result in the termination of access without refund or credit.

**3. User Name and Password.** The Subscriber will be recognized and authorized by the User Name and Password provided by the Subscriber in Item 1 above.

**4. Permitted use.** The Subscriber is permitted online access to the electronic version of JCE for which she or he maintains a current subscription, and may download or print text from JCE solely for the private use or research of the individual Subscriber. The Subscriber agrees to use this online access in a way that conforms with all applicable laws and regulations. - a. If JCE elects to discontinue the electronic version of the journal (termination would be effective at the end of the volume year, after the Subscriber had access to all electronic content for that volume year).
- b. Following 30 days’ prior written notice by JCE to the Subscriber that any term or condition of this License has been violated by the Subscriber, for any reason, knowingly or unknowingly, provided the violation is not remedied with all reasonable haste on notification. JCE reserves the right to suspend the Subscriber’s access to electronic content immediately upon detecting a breach of this License. JCE will use reasonable effort to notify the Subscriber as soon as possible using the e-mail address the Subscriber provided. No refund will be made for any portion of the subscription that may remain after termination.
- c. Following 30 days’ prior written notice by JCE of any change in the terms of this License, receipt by JCE of notice from the Subscriber in writing, or by e-mail or by fax, that the Subscriber does not accept such change or changes. (In the absence of any such objection by Subscriber, JCE’s new terms shall apply.) No refund will be made for any portion of the subscription that may remain after termination.

Neither JCE nor Subscribers shall be liable for any indirect, special, incidental, punitive, or consequential damages, including but not limited to the loss of data, interruption of business, or loss of profits arising out of the use of or the inability to use JCE content. In no event shall the total aggregate liability of JCE for any claims, losses, or damages arising out of any breach or termination of this agreement exceed the total amount paid by the Subscriber to JCE for the electronic version of JCE. The foregoing limitation of liability and exclusion of certain damages shall apply regardless of the success or effectiveness of other remedies. No claim may be made against JCE unless suit is filed within 1 year after the event giving rise to the claim. If JCE sends notice to the Subscriber of changes in the terms of this License, lack of response by the Subscriber within a 30-day period will be taken as acceptance of the new terms. The Subscriber may not make any changes to this License without written consent by JCE. The Subscriber may not assign or transfer its rights under this License. The provisions of Items 2, 4, 5, 7, 9, 10, 11, and 12 hereof shall survive any expiration or termination of this License. This License will be governed by, and construed in accordance with, the laws of the State of Maryland, applicable to contracts entered into and fully performed in the State of Maryland. An action arising out of, or relating to, this License or the electronic version of JCE shall be brought in courts situated in Washington County, Maryland, and the parties consent to the jurisdiction of such courts.
